### The rink

The venue is an open concept 40 meter by 20 meter rink within an 8000 square meter facility. The flooring is clean screeded cement. We recommend all athletes to consider the temperature of the air conditioned hall and the smoothness of the cement flooring to establish the most suitable wheels to use.

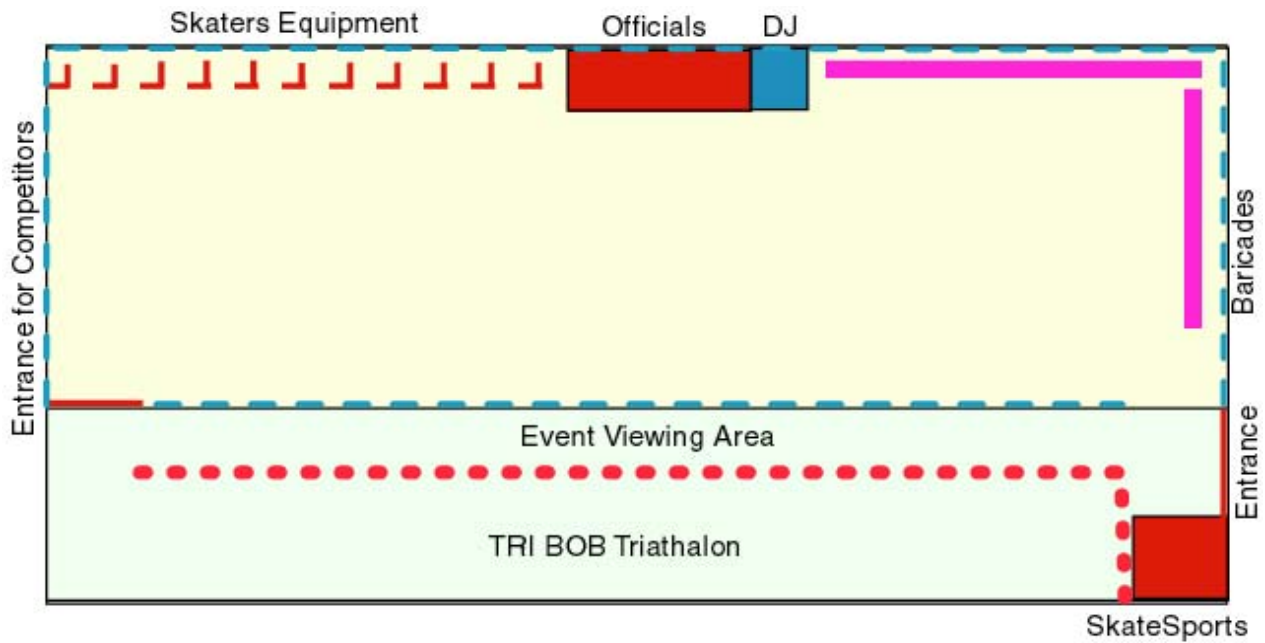
